

EMERGENCY CLOSINGS

The Superintendent may close the schools or dismiss them early in the event of hazardous weather or other emergencies. In making the decision to close schools, the Superintendent will consider many factors including the following:

1. Failure of buses to serve all parts of the school district.
2. Inability to furnish adequate heat in the school building or buildings to bring temperature of classrooms to a comfortable standard.
3. Blizzard conditions which include snow and high winds making it difficult to walk extended distances to and from school buildings.

The Superintendent will take action to close schools only after consultation with bus contractors and traffic and weather authorities.

Students, staff, and parents will be informed of the procedures which will be used to notify them in case of emergency closing.
