

Emergency Care Services Policy

A primary concern of the Kewaunee School Board is that proper attention be paid to the safety of students, staff, and visitors to the district. Therefore, the Board shall provide for emergency care services in the district.

The district administrator shall create and develop an emergency care team. The purpose of this team is to provide care until other medical practitioners arrive, until the person can be transported to the clinic, and/or to take care of minor injuries requiring minimal first aid. District personnel are not trained medical personnel, but can provide assistance to persons injured until trained medical practitioners can provide and direct the care.

In providing emergency care services, the Board shall:

- Arrange for a physician to serve as the district medial advisor. His/her duties shall include reviewing plans and policies for the implementation of the emergency care services program including facilities, suplies, procedures and training of designated personnel to provide emergency care.
- Ensure that procedures for emergency care are provided.
- Ensure that individuals, trained in first aid, are designated in each building and at all home school sponsored events to provide emergency care.
- Ensure the district has needed equipment and supplies to implement emergency care in the district.
- Require an annual review of the emergency care services program.
