

## **Scholarships Posted in the Counseling Office as of 4-29-19**

**PLEASE READ:** To obtain an application, either check in the Counseling Office (**paper copy**) or the website listed (**apply online**) for the scholarship.

### **National Scholarships (Name—Eligibility—Deadline)**

- 1) Fastweb Scholarships—FREE national scholarship search/ go to [www.fastweb.com](http://www.fastweb.com) to start. Deadline: varies.

### **Wisconsin Scholarships (Name—Eligibility—Deadline)**

- 1) Wisconsin TIP Grant—Must submit a FAFSA, and demonstrate large financial need. Financial need usually means low income students whose EFC (expected family contribution) is below \$200. Deadline: none given.
- 2) Kids Chance of Wisconsin Scholarship—Child of a parent that sustained a serious injury or fatality in a work related accident. Go to <https://kidschanceofwi.org/scholarship/> for more details. Deadline: May 1, 2019.
- 3) Ab Nicholas Scholarship—Must plan to attend a UW-System school. Must be a basketball participant through the senior year. Go to <https://abnicholasscholars.org/> to apply. Application window: February 1, 2019 through April 30, 2019.
- 4) WI Towns Association Scholarship—Open to all seniors. Essay required. Deadline: May 31, 2019.

### **Local Scholarships (Name—Eligibility—Deadline)**

- 1) Kewaunee County Garden Club Scholarship—Must reside in Kewaunee County. Must plan to pursue a Horticulture related field. Letters of recommendation needed. Ask for an application. Deadline: April 30, 2019.
- 2) American Veterans Post #42 Scholarship—Must have a 3.0 GPA or higher. Must be a child or grandchild of an American veteran. Deadline: April 30, 2019.
- 3) Students Who Make a Difference Scholarship—Must have been selected for the Student Who Makes a Difference Award during high school. Deadline: May 6, 2019.
- 4) Kewaunee Trap Club Scholarship—Open to ALL seniors. Deadline: May 1, 2019.

- 5) George Bahrke Memorial Scholarship 2019—Open to seniors. Must have participated in at least ONE co-curricular activity. Deadline: May 3, 2019.
- 6) Brad Vanness Scholarship Award: Helping Students Fulfill Their Dreams—Open to students planning to attend a technical college. Preference to those pursuing a program in Auto Tech, Diesel Tech, Digital Technology or Print Technology. Deadline: April 29, 2019.
- 7) Kali's School of Dance Scholarship—Must have participated in dance or performing arts during the high school years. Deadline: May 13, 2019.
- 8) Kewaunee County Tavern League Scholarship—Open to ALL seniors, but priority to those entering programs in Hospitality, Business, Accounting or Culinary Arts. Deadline: May 10, 2019.
- 9) Kewaunee County Lakes Association Scholarship—Open to students planning to pursue a program in Natural Resources, Environmental Science, Conservation or a related field. Deadline: May 24, 2019.
- 10) American Legion Post #29 Scholarship—Must be a blood relative of a present or deceased member of the American Legion or Legion Auxiliary. Applicant has participated in a legion sponsored activity—Badger Boys/ Girls, Youth Government, or Oratorical Contest. Deadline: May 13, 2019.
- 11) Lee W. Metzner Memorial Fund 2019 Scholarship—Open to ALL seniors. Deadline: May 14, 2019.
- 12) American Red Cross Scholarship—Must have actively participated in the KHS Blood Drive, either as a volunteer and/or blood donor. Deadline: May 14, 2019.

**Specific College Scholarships (Name—Eligibility—Deadline)**

- 1) NWTC Foundation Scholarships—Plan to attend NWTC. Go to <https://www.nwtc.edu/about-nwtc/departments/foundation-alumni/scholarships>. Log in at “my.NWTC,” click “student finances,” click “Scholarships.” Deadline: April 30, 2019.
